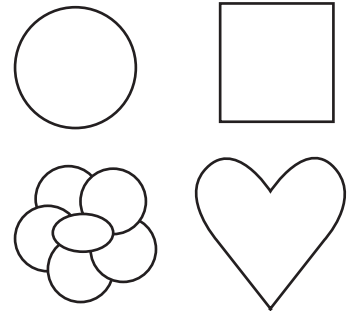


APPLIQUÉ

Applique involves applying shapes of one fabric onto another fabric using a zig zag stitch. The oldest piece of applique dates back to 980 BC.

FOR YOUR SAMPLE YOU WILL NEED: □

- 1) Piece of fabric 12cm x 12cm
- 2) Template shape (pattern paper or paper)
- 3) Different fabric piece for shape
- 4) Interfacing square 10cm x 10cm
- 5) Scissors, pins, sewing machine



STEP BY STEP GUIDE:

- 1) Get your template shape from a magazine or colouring book
- 2) Take your contrasting fabric and iron the interfacing on to the wrong side
make sure the shiney side is down
- 3) Iron your other piece of fabric
- 4) Pin your template on to the right side of the interfaced fabric and cut out
- 5) Pin your cut out shape on to your 12cm x 12cm square
- 6) Zig zag around the shape on the sewing machine
- 7) You can zig zag around the edge of the square to make your sample look better presented
- 8) Cut off any loose threads and mount your sample on to your presentation sheet
